Course aim

To learn basic swing techniques, the etiquette of the game and provide confidence to venture onto the golf course.

Course outcomes

- Hit the golf ball more than 50 yards
- Putt 3 out of 5 balls from 3 feet
- Understand how to mark a scorecard appropriately
- Chip 3 out of 5 balls onto a putting green from 30 yards
- State the basic etiquette of the game

How will the course be taught?

Mainly on the driving range, putting green and sometimes indoors. Practical instruction, demonstration and theory input.

What do I need to bring / have ready?

No equipment is required; please wear comfortable clothing that you can move in with a light rain mac if you wish. Trainers or suitable flat shoes are required for steady footing. £2 per week for range balls. Golf clubs are available to borrow at no extra charge.
