Course aim

Ever wanted to learn to paint and draw but don't know where to start? Or want to rediscover your skills? Then this is the course for you. Learn techniques in a relaxed, social environment; experimenting with different media and styles. Explore a different approach each week, working from still -life, photographs and abstraction; finishing with the chance to develop your own personal project.

Course Outcomes

- a) Apply rules of composition and perspective to still life, landscape and more complex subjects
- b) Use and experiment with a range of techniques and media
- c) Explore and evaluate the possibilities of Line in drawing and painting
- d) Explore and evaluate the application of Tone to create form with marks and brushstrokes
- e) Select the appropriate tools and media for the development of your work

How will the course be taught?

Demonstration, 1:1 tuition, handouts, practical work, step by step exercises, group critique, own research, pair work and self evaluation.

Sketchbook or drawing paper; drawing pencils, eraser, colour pencils, watercolour paints, any paint brushes, paint pallet and water pots that you may already have.
