Course aim

To develop a range of mechanical skills to give the basic ability of vehicle repair which includes theoretical knowledge and practical skills of vehicle systems and repair.

Course outcomes

a. Identify the main components of the cooling and ventilation systems. Check fluid levels and fluid concentration, perform thermostat tests.

b. Identify all the components of the braking system and explain each of their functions.

c. Identify the main components of the lubrication system, to be able to perform oil changes and correct oil level checks and types of oil for varying vehicles.

d. Identify the structure and meaning of wheels and tyres including changing tyres using the tyre changing machine.

How will the course be taught?

Classroom and workshop sessions conducted by motor vehicle instructors.
