An Introduction to Embroidery: starting with Sashiko; Japanese running stitch and how this simple running stitch is used to form texture, interest and provide pleasure in its uncomplicated nature and simplicity of use.

A practical stitch course engaging learners in a sewing form that creates pleasure in its simplicity.

Course outcomes

Using words to enable form and design within a boundary; Sashiko stitch enables its simplicity to shine. We add colour and texture to create interest.

Sashiko Kitty - using a template create shape and form to create a mini kitty plus Bullion and French knots.

Whilst finishing projects, engage in stitch discussion and learn a little of Sashiko stitch development.
