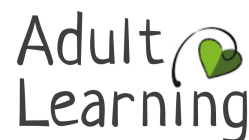

The course will look at castles, domestic, ecclesiastical and industrial buildings and artefacts of the medieval period, and how those buildings and artefacts changed over time. We will also look at changes in the landscape that took place as a result of the period ie. farming.

Course Outcomes

- Identify different types of architecture of the medieval period
- Appreciate how buildings and the landscape changed over time and why
- Carry out a table top assessment of buildings to detect phases of development within the building

How will the course be taught?

Lecture and practical classes such as using maps to look at distribution patterns, drawing of artefacts, use of maps, plans and historical sources.

Could I gain a certificate?

No prior qualifications or experience needed as the course will start with the very basics of the period and the archaeology.
