Course Description

You will develop figurative techniques through human body observation and develop use/understanding of line, tone, shape and form while drawing the human body in a number of poses and art materials.

Course Outcomes

- a) Use observational skills to draw and paint the human form and anatomy that relate to contemporary and historical art practices
- b) Identify and describe how the different parts of the human body relate to each other
- c) Demonstrate the effects of positive and negative space
- d) Use and experiment with different media and drawing techniques to note special characteristics and expressively describe shape and form

How will the course be taught?

Practical, 1:1 support, demonstration, handouts and group discussion in a relaxed and supportive setting (a nude life model will be present at each session)

What do I need to bring?

- a) A few Soft Pencils either 3b or 6b grade
- b) A Sketch pad A2 with cartridge paper
- c) Some Charcoal sticks
