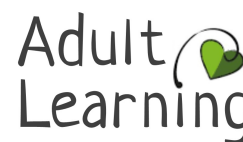

What will I learn?

In this course you will learn how to use a DSLR or Bridge camera in aperture priority, shutter priority and when to use flash manually; Use histograms to check exposure, how to use flash compensation and explore good use of composition, context and content; present a selection of images using current technology.

What will I need to take part?

You need a DSLR/BRIDGE Camera, manuals, leads. These courses are not suitable for compact cameras.

Please bring a notebook and pen.

What to expect

The course is taught by tutor demonstration and practical activities with critique of images in a group and individual support. You will complete an individual project with one -to-one support. Be prepared to practise between sessions.
