

Course description

Course Outcomes

How will the course be taught?

A communicative approach is used. All four skills (speaking, reading, listening, and writing) are practised with the main emphasis on speaking. Learners engage in interactive language activities, participating in group and pair work. Learners will also be offered guidance in self-study and set optional homework tasks.

Could I gain a certificate?

No, there is no gaining a certificate. The course is aimed at learners with general interest in the language and have had 60 hours of previous learning the language.

Writing materials, you may need to buy a course book, the tutor will advise you.
