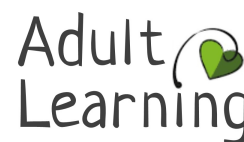

To equip learners with the information necessary to write basic HTML 4 and CSS script and make changes, configure meta tags, embed images and link pages.

Course outcomes

- Configure Keyword and Description meta tags
- Describe the difference between HTML and CSS script
- Know how to upload a web page to the internet
- Distinguish between the header and body sections on a web page
- Configure image tags, create links and embed photographs

Practical tutor-led workshop using a combination of teaching resources including: handouts, Powerpoint, white board, computer, digital resources, software and online material.
