

Course aim

To create a range of different floral designs and styles, using a mix of textured foliage from the garden, considering the elements and principles of design.

Course Outcomes

- c) Cost an arrangement for a client
- d) Make a handtied bouquet
- e) Enhance designs with different flower arranging techniques

How will the course be taught?

Hands on practical, plus one to one support, handouts and demonstrations

What do I need to bring/have ready?

For the first lesson you will need to bring strong scissors, twigs, and a mixture of three- four different types of foliage, considering their visual texture and colour. Plus £4.00 for a container and sundries from the tutor. On some of the weeks there may be an optional cost between £5 - £10 for different foliage and materials.
