## What do I need to bring / have ready?

If possible please bring your own crochet hooks and wool. The tutor will have a few sets available for purchase. A size 3.5/4.0mm hook is good for most people to start with. A light colour double knitting wool is best for starting as you can see the stitches more clearly. Do not choose baby wool, fluffy or bobbly wool for starting.
