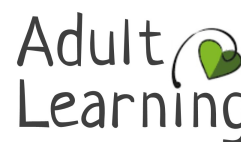

Course aim

The aim of this course is to improve the 4 abilities of learning Spanish at an intermediate level while studying and reinforcing grammar topics and, enabling you to develop an ability to communicate effectively. Pair work and group discussions using the textbook Pasos 2 and other materials provided by the teacher. In class, students will work, learn and speak together.

Course outcomes

- a) improve fluency through regular practice and speaking drills at an intermediate level.
- b) expand vocabulary such as personal, historical and/or fictitious situations through homework, exercises, and class work
- c) revise, compare and develop the uses of the 3 past tenses in Spanish through reading, listening, speaking and writing tasks
- d) practice natural flow of speaking and listening, to open and keep conversations going when talking about our past.

How will the course be taught?

A communicative approach is used. All four skills (speaking, reading, listening, and writing) are practised with the main emphasis on speaking. Learners engage in interactive language activities, participating in group and pair work. Learners will also be offered guidance in self-study and set optional homework tasks.

What do I need to bring / have ready?

Pen and paper for note taking, a small Spanish dictionary if you have one. The book used for this course is Pasos 2. Other material such as handouts will be sent by email.
