### Course aim

This is a course delivered online using Zoom by the Northamptonshire Adult Learning Service. This is a follow on course from the very popular 'Strike A Pose' Art History Part 1 course which was introduced in the summer. The course will focus on "Exploring development of Art History Hierarchy": Embarking on a journey of discovery we will trace some of the origins and development of Historical, Portraiture, Genre genre, Landscape and Still life genres. Dating from the 1300's through to the Modern period and into the 20th century, this whistle stop, 5 week tour will each session explore one of the art history hierarchical genres.

### Course Outcomes

- Recap, discuss and describe the hierarchy of art work covered in Part 1 of the course. For each of the genres, one covered each week learners will
- Identify what defines the genre and its timeline.
- Be able to discuss examples of the genre
- Be able to compare and contrast the genres.
