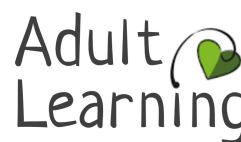

Multiply

Multiply is a 3 year programme funded through the Department for Education aimed at supporting adults to increase their skills in numeracy. Those who improve their numeracy skills are more likely to be in employment, have higher wages and better wellbeing.

Our free numeracy courses are for individuals:

- resident in North or West Northamptonshire, aged 19 and over
- that have not achieved a maths GCSE of at least a Grade C or equivalent
- who may want to develop numeracy skills for work or progression
- that want to brush up and develop their numeracy skills for everyday life.

Course aim

For learners to develop their confidence and skills across all areas of Maths at a specific and targeted level to allow them to confidently progress on to achieve the next level of qualification. The course is designed for those learners who have previously achieved at this level but have since lost confidence and skills and are unable to successfully access the next level of their education without this support.

Course outcomes

- To gain confidence in simple calculations in everyday maths.
- To apply knowledge and understanding of maths to everyday situations.
- To recognise the progress you need to make to stretch and challenge yourself in maths.
- To prepare you for the full Functional Skills maths course.

How will the course be taught?

This course will be taught with lots of practical elements including group, pair and individual work.

What do I need to bring / have ready?

You may choose to bring a dictionary to support with any translations you may need. You may also like to bring a notepad and pen/pencil to record any notes that you would like to make to support you with your learning
