Course Outcomes

- b) Select and order materials needed to make your designs
- c) Use hand tools and traditional jewellery techniques to construct a number of wearable jewellery pieces
- d) Research and identify techniques used by contemporary practicing jewellers
- e) Describe safe use of jewellery tools and methods

How will the course be taught?

A variety of teaching methods are used including: demonstration, group participation and individual support. Resources such as handouts and videos are used to enhance learning.

What do I need to bring / have ready?

Sketchpad (at least A4 size), pencils, pen, A4 plastic wallet (for keeping handouts), glue stick, scissors and an object or image of a form that inspires you - this could be from nature or a man -made item although try to avoid a piece of jewellery.
